



67% of Canadians have never been tested for HCV



44% of those living with HCV don't know they have it.


OFFER TESTING TO: Offer one time testing to anyone born between 1945 - 1975

Retesting should be preformed at least annually in those individuals engaged in ongoing high-risk activities. Re-screening must be done with HCV RNA, as antiHCV will remain positive even after cure or spontaneous resolution of virus.



Clinical clues or symptoms of liver disease (Such as elevated ALT for > 6 months)




